The Pupil Premium – Recovery Steering Group (the Group) has been formed by the Directors' Board on behalf of the Members.

The Group will comprise of representation from The Executive and Directors' Boards. The Group is empowered to second in additional individuals, on a meeting-by-meeting basis, if it is felt that such individuals will bring relevant expertise to any of the Group's meeting agendas. The Group will meet at least termly and minutes will be taken by someone nominated for the purpose from the Group.

The Group has no delegated powers, other than the power to temporarily second in suitable experts as noted above, and to establish working parties; but has key responsibilities in advising and making strategic policy recommendations in-line with the Trust's Strategic Development Plan to The Executive Board and Directors' Board, and in overseeing the implementation plans and work of the working parties. The Group's remit is:

1. To have oversight of how settings support pupils to catch up for lost teaching during the coronavirus pandemic;
2. To have oversight of how settings help disadvantaged pupils by improving their progress and attainment;
3. To make recommendations regarding strategic policy;
4. To make recommendations regarding the sharing of best practice and support of CPD needs.
